Research at the **Department of Cognitive Science** concentrates on, but is not restricted to, the study of human social cognition: how learning, processing and sharing information about and with others takes place. The study of social cognition links psychological processes to economic and political behavior and to the cultural transmission of social conventions and ideas. It is highly relevant for theorizing about the biological and social roots of the human mind. Students may take courses in cognitive psychology, philosophy of mind, cognitive anthropology, computational cognition and linguistics, and they receive practical research training in methods, experimental design and data analysis. Graduates can move into research and teaching positions, meeting the growing demand for experts in social cognitive science.
