



Ph.D. Position (Cognitive Psychology)

A Ph.D. position is available within the “Cognition and Action” lab of the Department of Psychology at the University of Tübingen (Germany). Salary is according to 65% E-13 and is contracted for 24 months first, but an extension of the contract is possible. The position is filled at the earliest possible date.

The lab focuses on Cognitive Psychology. Emphases are the interplay of action and perception, dual-task performance, and working memory. An interest in one of these topics is desired, though the position is open to a variety of other topics.

The successful applicant is expected to hold a Master degree (or “Diplom”) with a Major in Psychology or a neighboring discipline (e.g., Cognitive Science, ...) and to have an interest in the experimental analysis of human cognition and behavior. Useful are first experiences in programming computer-based experiments, analyzing data, and solid knowledge of English. The applicant’s own scientific qualification (in particular, pursuit of a Ph.D. project) is possible and clearly aspired. **Applications from all countries are invited.**
