

10th International Conference on the Structure of Hungarian

Call for Papers

We are pleased to announce the 10th International Conference on the Structure of Hungarian (ICSH10) to be held in Lund, Sweden on **25-27 August, 2011**. The conference is organized jointly by the Center of Languages and Literature, Lund University, Lund, Sweden, and the Research Institute for Linguistics of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences, Budapest, Hungary.

Abstract submission deadline: **February 28th, 2011**

Notification of acceptance/rejection: April 25th, 2011

Abstracts are solicited for 30-minute presentations (plus 10 minutes for discussion) that make a contribution to our understanding of the structure of the language and/or the structure of linguistic theory, including any characteristic of the morphology, phonetics, phonology, syntax, semantics, pragmatics, psycholinguistics, sociolinguistics, neurolinguistics or historical linguistics of Hungarian.

The conference will host a special workshop on “Approaches to Uralic Languages and Scandinavian”. Abstracts are welcome in the following topics: phonetics, phonology, morphology, syntax, argument structure, semantics, information structure and historical linguistics of Scandinavian and Uralic languages.
